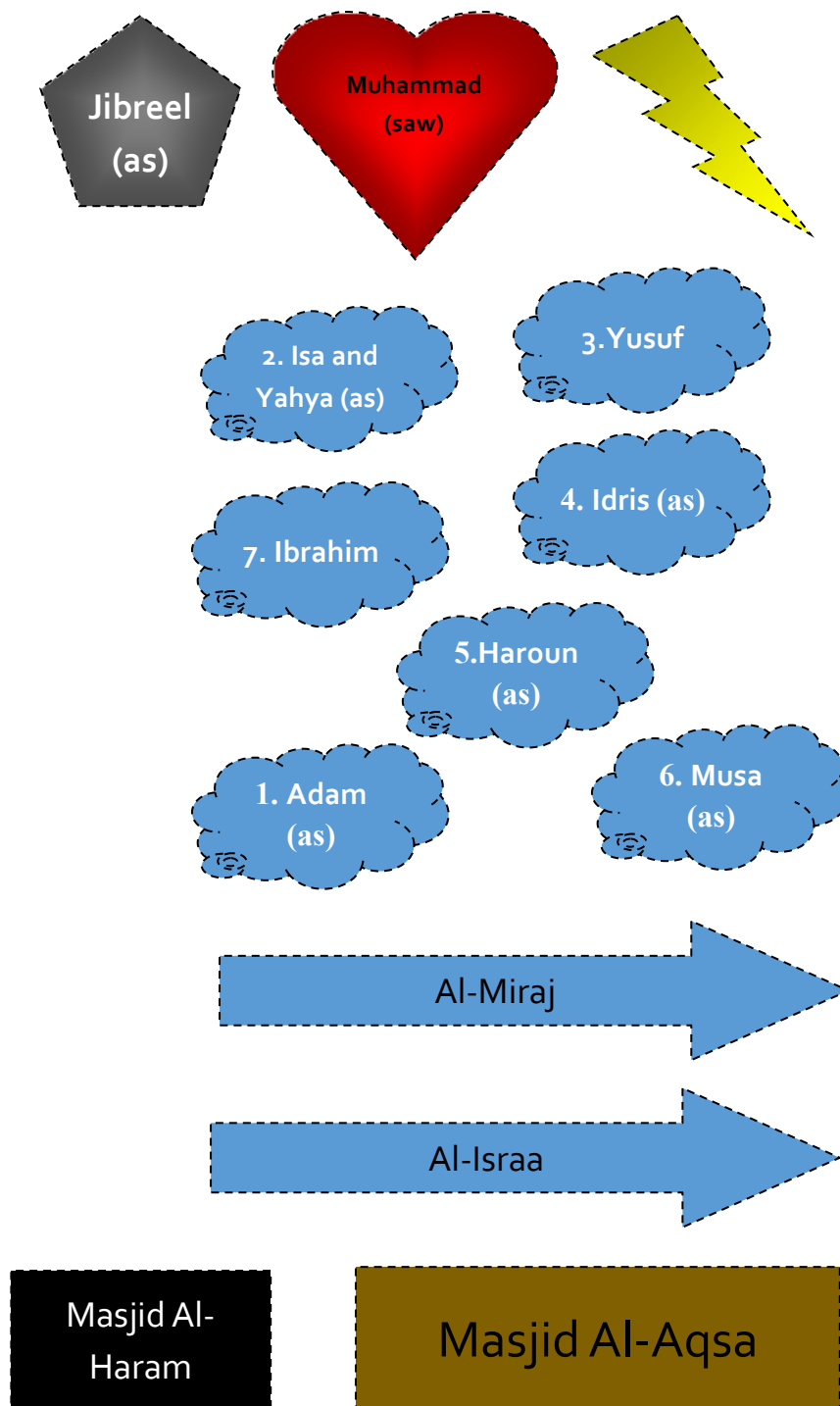


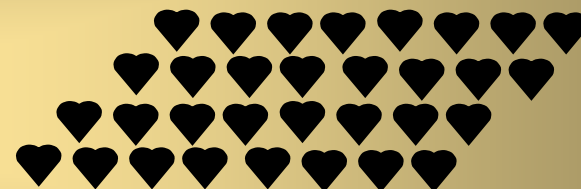
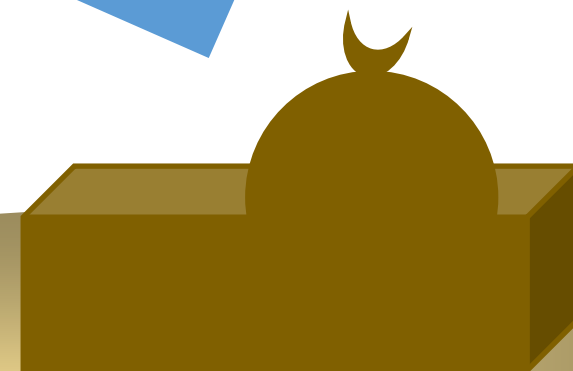
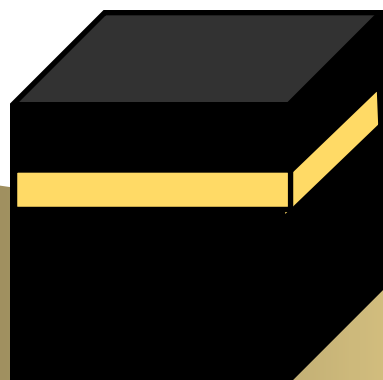
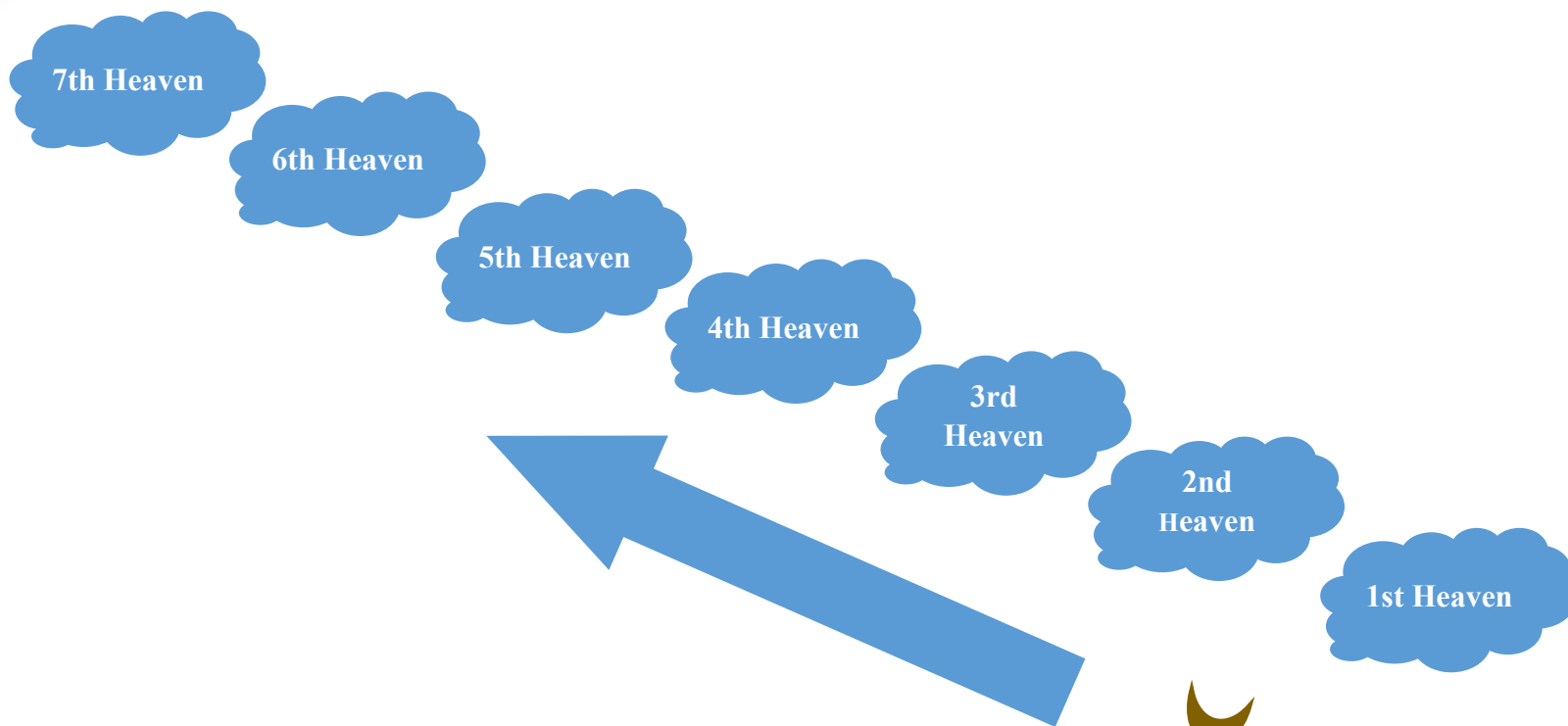
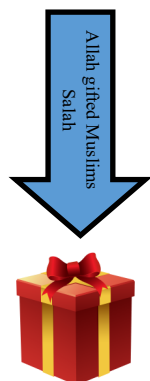
Important points to be made by educator:

- Cut all of the shapes on the right . Use pentagon, heart, and lightening bolt as game pieces moving across the worksheet.
- Paste the remaining shapes in the correct section on following page.
- Link the heart, pentagon, and lightening bolt together to show how Muhammed did not travel alone, but with the help of Angel Jibreel (as) and the Buraq.
- Journey was a miracle from Allah (swt) to strengthened the belief of the Prophet (saw) and his companions.
- Israa and Miraj came at a very difficult time in the Prophet's life when his wife and uncle passed away (sad year).
- Allah sent Jibreel and a Buraq (literal meaning lightening because of lightening speed) to Muhammed (saw)
- Trip made from Masjid Al-Haram to Masjid Al-Aqsa is called Al-Israa (literal meaning to run swiftly)
- Muhammad (saw) prayed at Masjid Al Aqsa with all of the previous prophets.
- Trip from Masjid Al Aqsa to 7 heavens is called Al-Miraj (literal meaning ladder).
- Bait Al-Mamoor is a place in heaven directly above the Kaaba.
- Allah's gifted humanity the way of performing Prayer as a result of this miraculous journey.
